The Tony Jannus Distinguished Aviation Society has named Hawaiian Airlines President & Chief Executive Officer Peter Ingram as the 2024 Tony Jannus Award recipient, presented annually to a leader who has made major and lasting contributions to the commercial aviation industry. This year marks the 60th anniversary of the award.

The award, which is given to top names in the commercial aviation industry and celebrates the Tampa Bay region's history as the birthplace of commercial aviation, will be presented to Ingram at an Awards Dinner on Saturday Nov. 16, 2024, at the J.W. Marriott in Tampa.

"Peter Ingram personifies what the Tony Jannus Award represents: Innovation and excellence in the aviation industry," said Laurie Goossens, 2024 Tony Jannus Society Chair. "His steady leadership at Hawaiian serves as a benchmark for success in the commercial aviation industry and we could not be more delighted to honor him."

Ingram joined Hawaiian as Chief Financial Officer in November 2005 and served as Executive Vice President and Chief Commercial Officer from November 2011 through February 2018 before his appointment as President & CEO.

During his tenure at the company, Hawaiian Airlines has expanded into the Asia/Pacific and Oceania regions, solidified its position as a U.S. leader for operational performance, and delivered the highest levels of customer service.

Prior to joining Hawaiian Airlines, Ingram spent 11 years with American Airlines and American Eagle. Ingram earned his M.B.A. from Duke University's Fuqua School of Business and graduated with honors from the University of Western Ontario.

"It's an honor to accept this award on behalf of my 7,000-plus colleagues at Hawaiian Airlines," said Ingram. "I am privileged to work alongside a team committed to running an outstanding airline and welcoming our guests with authentic Hawaiian hospitality. This recognition reflects their success delivering on our mission to connect people with aloha."
